Painting of Brick, Stone, and Masonry Facades

Facades should be inspected / Cleaned regularly to ensure the integrity of the brick and concrete joints. Depending on location and environmental conditions typically a stone facade maintenance cycles should be every 2 – 5 years. *This is not LLTI inspection, however if your cycle is due this would be the best time. *
